LOCAL RULES

USGA and the following Local Rules shall govern play at Callippe Preserve Golf Course:

· Areas of the Course Requiring Preservation; Environmentally Sensitive Areas: Please do not enter Environmentally Sensitive Areas that are on or adjoin the course. These areas are defined as Water Hazards and identified by Red or Yellow stakes with Green tops. The player must, under penalty of one stroke, proceed under <u>Rule 26-1</u>.

• If player's ball lays within the playing area, but is impeded by an Environmentally Sensitive Area,

the player must take relief. Proceed under Rule 26-1c.

- Out-of-Bounds: Defined by the inside edges at ground level of White stakes, by perimeter fences, and paved perimeter roads.
- Staked Trees: If swing or stance is apt to touch, or ball lies in a basin around a staked tree, ball MUST be lifted and dropped, without penalty, within one club-length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole.
- · Yardage: All vardages are measured to the center of the green.

• Flower Beds: Drop no closer to the hole; no penalty.

• French Drains: Drop within one club-length, no closer to the hole, no penalty.

• Drop zone located across hazard on Hole 10

ETIOUETTE

- Pace of Play: In the interest of all, players should complete their round in 4 and 1/2 hours. If a player or group fails to maintain its schedule and position on the course, they may be required to advance their ball to the correct position. In this instance, please implement the USGA's 'par-plus' formula to record your score for that hole(s).
- · Courtesy to Others: Please repair pitch marks, replace divots, and rake bunkers.

PLAYER RESPONSIBILITY

- Damage to Homes/Property: Players are responsible for damage to surrounding homes and/or
 property (i.e., broken window or dent in car). Please identify yourself to the owner.
- Dress Code: Players are reminded that they should be properly attired both during play and in the clubhouse. Proper attire consists of a shirt with sleeves and collar, and tailored trousers or shorts. No tank tops permitted.
- Golf Carts: You must be over 18 years old and have a valid driver's license to operate a golf cart. Two riders per cart maximum.

Metal Spikes are not allowed.

• Reporting: All players must report to the Pro Shop prior to teeing off.

No outside food or beverages allowed on the course.

Cart Path Only holes 1, 18 and all par 3's.
